Jonathan's place is an organization that brings in a safe space for children, teens, and young adults who have been neglected and abused. Listed below is the different programs Jonathan's place offers:

- Emergency Shelter a residential facility for newborns and children up to 18 year old's
- Foster care and Adoption program a program that recruits, trains and supports foster and adoptive parents
- Girls Residential Treatment a program that provides a home for girls ages 10-18 who
 need specialized treatment due to the experience of neglect and any type of abuse.
- Safe Place- a national outreach and runaway prevention program that teaches middle and high schoolers about abuse and how to reach out if needed.
- Transitional Living Program- a program that helps young adults from the ages of 17-23
 who are just getting out of foster care with housing, mental and physical health,
 education, and more
